April 2, 2024 Ballot - Operation Budget Question: What is this question really asking and how can the mill rate remain the same?

- This question is not asking for an additional tax levy. It is <u>only asking for the permission</u> to exceed the state mandated operational revenue limit WHILE MAINTAINING Bristol's current school-related tax rate.
- This question gives Bristol School permission to use funds that have already been levied. Essentially, we are asking for permission to reallocate
 resources. In simpler terms, it involves transferring funds from one allocation to another, without any intention of introducing an additional tax levy.

Important Reminders:

• **NEW! Student Work From Home Due to Anticipated School Closures Framework:** Due to the exhaustion of this year's inclement weather days, Bristol School will implement work-from-home days to avoid makeup days at the year's end. Families should review the new framework for anticipated closures, as the district is dedicated to preparing both staff and students for potential disruptions caused by inclement weather.

NEW FRAMEWORK! Anticipated School Closures - Student Learn From Home Day

- 1. The district will communicate during each school closure whether or not students will have a "Learn From Home day".
- 2. Teachers will communicate with families the best way to contact them for any questions or support needed.
- 3. Activities and work sent home will serve as our method of taking attendance during the school closure.
- 4. If your child engages in the activities prepared by the teachers during the school closure, your child will be counted as "present".
- 5. If your child does not engage in the activities prepared by the teachers during the school closure, your child will be counted as "absent".
- NEW! Emergency Closures and Bristol's Communication Pathways: In the event of an emergency, Bristol is committed to disseminating timely communication through the appropriate channels for the specific circumstance. These communication pathways include emails (sent from the address noreply@bristol.k12.wi.us), recorded phone calls, text messages, emergency website banners (distinguished by red banners displayed across every page on our website), and/or district social media accounts. We kindly ask that if you hear that the district has issued communication, please check multiple channels before reaching out to the school directly. This practice ensures that crucial information reaches you promptly and through the most relevant means. If you believe you are not receiving district wide communication, please submit a help ticket here.
- NEW! Accurate Family Contact Information is Important! We ask that all families log into their Skyward: Family Access account and verify all of their personal contact information. To verify your contact information log into your Skyward: Family Access account, select the "My account", make any necessary updates to contacting information and hit the "Save" button. Need a Skyward: Family Access Username or password reset? Click the Forgot your Login/Password link found under the Sign In button to receive a reset link via email. If at any point, you don't receive Bristol School District communication, please submit a help ticket by completing this form.
- **NEW! Skyward Parent Notifications Update:** We are continuing to troubleshoot the email notifications from Skyward. Please continue logging directly into your Skyward: Family Access account to check for any messages from teachers. You can also download the Skyward app for your smartphone or tablet and enable push notifications. We will continue to share updates as we work toward a solution. Thank you for your patience.
- **UPDATE! Nurse Important Reminders:** Please do not send your child to school if they have had diarrhea or vomiting in the last 24 hours. If your child has required the use of fever-reducing medications, they may return to school once their symptoms have subsided for 24 hours after the last dose. <u>Please review this graphic to help you determine when your child stays home and when they can come back to school.</u>
- **UPDATE! Appropriate Weather Wear:** As the temperature varies, please be sure to dress your children appropriately for the weather. Our goal is to have students outside for regularly scheduled recess. The following guidelines during the winter months determine whether or not to have recess the following thresholds will be considered using "feels like" and/or wind chill temperatures: 10.F and above: full outdoor recess, Between 0-9.F: Shortened recess, Below 0.F: Remain indoors
- NEW! Bristol School District #1's ACP & Future Readiness Plan: We are excited to share Bristol School District's updated Academic & Career Planning (ACP) & Future Readiness Plan. This plan is updated annually and is designed to help students prepare for future success and is an "ongoing process of implementation, review, evaluation, and refinement as a district implements the components of college and career readiness" (DPI, 2022).
