- **NOW - 4/8/24 - 4K and Kindergarten Enrollment Window Extended to April 8th!** Visit our webpage to [download the enrollment form](#), review testimonials, and learn more!

- **3/8/24 - End of Second Trimester:** Keep the end of the second trimester on your radar! If your child has late or missing work that needs to be submitted, please keep in mind what has been communicated through the Student and Parent Handbook: For school work that is not submitted by the communicated deadlines, students should expect delayed feedback and grading from teachers. *Any late school work must be submitted at least five school days prior to the end of the trimester to be factored into the grades of that marking period.*
- **3/8/24 - PTO's "Ready, Set, Glow Dance Party" from 6-8pm:** This dance party that includes a professional DJ, face paint, games, and more is geared towards ALL grade levels. A guardian must attend with students. No permission slip required. We encourage everyone to dress to GLOW in blacklight. Entry is \$5 per person with a max of \$20 per family. All families will pay at the door with cash or check. No credit cards will be accepted for entry or concessions. All concessions will be available for cash purchasing and will benefit the 8th-grade Washington DC trip.

- **REMINDER! 23-24 Summer School (Registration information is coming soon):** In consideration of families' planning needs, we are sharing the following tentative 23-24 summer school information.
 1. Scheduled from June 17-June 28 and July 8-July 19 - Monday through Friday; no school Monday, July 1st - Friday, July 5th.
 2. Only available for students currently attending Kindergarten through 7th grade at Bristol School for the 2023-2024 school year.
 3. Limited to the first 100 students to register due to reduced available classroom space as a result of phase 2 construction.
 4. Each grade band (K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-7) is limited to 25 students.
 5. All summer school days are tentatively scheduled from 8am to 11:45am.
 6. The curriculum will focus on strengthening students' literacy and numeracy skills, leadership, and learning through problem-solving and project-based learning as well as team-building activities.
 7. No breakfast, lunch, or transportation will be provided; students are to bring a water bottle and daily snack.
 8. Kids Club (after summer school care) is available at an additional cost; information will be provided during registration.
