## **Important Upcoming Dates:**

- NOW 4/8/24 4K and Kindergarten Enrollment Window Extended to April 8th! <u>Visit our webpage to download the enrollment form, review</u> testimonials, and learn more!
- 4/8/24 Schoolwide Solar Eclipse Viewing: To celebrate this rare event, we are hosting a schoolwide eclipse viewing for our entire student body from 2:00 2:15 pm, weather permitting. The peak of the eclipse will be occurring at approximately 2:08 pm in our area. It is important to note that certified eye protection must be used at all times when viewing the eclipse. The Bristol PTO is providing NASA approved glasses for students to wear to view the eclipse. Additionally, some students will have recess during the timeframe of the eclipse (12:52 3:21 pm). Glasses will be provided for viewing while out during normally scheduled recess time. We also ask that you communicate with your child the importance of not looking at the sun without the appropriate eye protection.
