Please review the important upcoming announcements compiled by Bristol's Administrative Team.

### Important Upcoming Dates:

- **4/16/24 - 4K In-Person Screening Appointments:** To participate in the 4K in-person screening appointments, it is required for all families to have submitted their child's entrance packet, including proof of residency and birth certificate. Once all documents have been turned in, you will receive an email link to complete the 4K questionnaire and sign up for a screening appointment.
- **4/17/24 - EARLY RELEASE!** Don't forget - early release is Wednesday, April 17th. Student dismissal is at 1:15pm!
- **4/17/24 - Regular Board Meeting begins at 4:30pm:** This meeting will be held in the Large Group Instruction room also called the LGI (previously where the District Office was located). Please park in the Hwy. 45 parking lot and enter through Door 13.
- **4/22/24 - No School - Professional Learning for Teaching Staff!**
- **4/22/24 - 7th & 8th Grade School Make-Up Day (Asynchronous Learning Day):** All 7th and 8th-grade students will need to participate in an asynchronous learning day on Monday, April 22, 2024, as a response to the three school cancellations this academic year and to fulfill the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction requirements.
  1. Asynchronous learning means students will complete activities and work from home and at their own pace. Activities and work will be posted on Google Classroom for students to engage in.
  2. Classroom teachers will be offering office hours from 1:00 - 2:00pm to support students with any of the activities. Teachers will be available for phone, email, or Google meet conversations at this time. If students would like to meet via Google meet, they should email their teacher with such a request.
  3. Attendance: "Present": Students must engage in the activities prepared by the teachers within three days of the asynchronous learning day; "Absent": Students that do not engage in teacher prepared activities.

- **4/29/24 - 3-Year-Old Birthday Party** - New or soon-to-be 3-year-olds are welcome to Bristol School on April 29 from 11:15am to 12:30pm for a birthday party and developmental screening. Children and parents will play, sing a happy birthday song, and have a birthday treat. Children will also be screened by our team in the areas of language/communication, academics/cognition, social/emotional skills, and motor skills. - **5/10/24 - Library books are due! All library materials are due from students and staff on Friday, May 10th!**
- **Summer School 2024-** Summer School registration will go out in an email on Monday, April 15th. Please review the following important information about this year's summer school:
  1. Only available for students currently attending Kindergarten through 7th grade at Bristol School.
  2. Limited to the first 100 students to register due to reduced available classroom space as a result of construction.
  3. Online registration must be completed for EACH individual current Bristol student (family registration is not available)
  4. Each grade band (K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-7) is limited to 25 students.
  5. Summer school registration will open on Monday, April 15th at 4:30pm thru Sunday, April 28th at 11:59pm.
  6. Scheduled from June 17-June 28 and July 8-July 19 - Monday through Friday; no School Monday, July 1st - Friday, July 5th.
  7. All summer school days will be from 8am to 11:45am.
  8. The curriculum will focus on strengthening students' literacy and numeracy skills, leadership, and learning through problem-solving and project-based learning as well as team-building activities.
  9. No breakfast, lunch, or transportation will be provided; students are encouraged to bring a water bottle and daily snack.
  10. Kids Club (after summer school care) is available at an additional cost; information will be provided during registration.
