Important Upcoming Dates:

- Now 5/1/24 Summer School 2024 Registration Now Open! Register using the online permission form found in parents' <u>Skyward: Family Access</u> <u>Account</u>; one registration form per child. Summer School is scheduled Monday through Friday from June 17-June 28 and July 8-July 19, 8am to 11:45am. There will be no school Monday, July 1st, through Friday, July 8th. Due to reduced available classroom space as a result of construction, registration is limited to 25 students per grade band (K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-7). No breakfast, lunch, or transportation will be provided. Students are to bring a water bottle and daily snack. Kids Club (after summer school care) is available at an additional cost.
- 4/22/24 No School Professional Learning for Teaching Staff!
- 4/22/24 7th & 8th Grade School Make-Up Day (Asynchronous Learning Day): All 7th and 8th-grade students will need to participate in an
 asynchronous learning day on Monday, April 22, 2024, as a response to the three school cancellations this academic year and to fulfill the Wisconsin
 Department of Public Instruction requirements.
- 1. Asynchronous learning means students will complete activities and work from home and at their own pace. Activities and work will be posted on Google Classroom for students to engage in.
- 2. Classroom teachers will be offering office hours from 1:00 2:00pm to support students with any of the activities. Teachers will be available for phone, email, or Google Meet conversations at this time. If students would like to meet via Google Meet, they should email their teacher with such a request.
- 3. Attendance: "Present": Students must engage in the activities prepared by the teachers within three days of the asynchronous learning day; "Absent: Students that do not engage in teacher-prepared activities.
