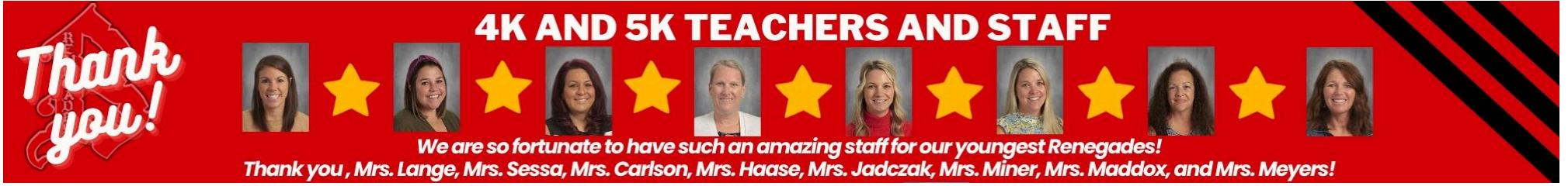

Important Upcoming Dates:

- **Now - 5/1/24 - Summer School 2024 Registration Now Open!** Register using the online permission form found in parents' [Skyward: Family Access Account](#); one registration form per child. Summer School is scheduled Monday through Friday from June 17-June 28 and July 8-July 19, 8am to 11:45am. There will be no school Monday, July 1st, through Friday, July 8th. Due to reduced available classroom space as a result of construction, registration is limited to 25 students per grade band (K-1, 2-3, 4-5, 6-7). No breakfast, lunch, or transportation will be provided. Students are to bring a water bottle and daily snack. Kids Club (after summer school care) is available at an additional cost.
- **4/29/24 - 3-Year-Old Birthday Party** - New or soon-to-be 3-year-olds are welcome to Bristol School on April 29 from 11:15am to 12:30pm for a birthday party and developmental screening.
