#### Important Reminders:

- NEW! Forward Test Results: Individual student Forward Results will be coming home with 4th through 8th grade students today. If your child was enrolled at Bristol School last year and is currently in 4th through 8th grade, please look for the test results. Note that you will not receive an additional copy if you picked up the results during Open House.
- REMINDER! Arrival, Dismissal Drop-Off & Pick Up Information: The start of the school day is 7:35am\*. All students should be in their classes ready to learn at that time. Visit our Bristol School Home Webpage to review important attendance, arrival and dismissal information. We ask that all parents review the 23-24 Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures! \*Students arriving after 7:35am will need to be checked in at the school office by their parents and will be considered tardy.
- REMINDER! Fall MAP Growth Testing: This year, fall MAP Growth Testing will only take place for certain grade levels/content areas. This decision
  is to prioritize student learning and to gather the most valuable instructional insights. While MAP Growth is a valuable tool to provide general school
  trends and individual student progress over time, in some cases, other assessments are available that provide teachers with more actionable
  information, especially at the start of the school year. All grades will engage in winter and spring MAP Growth assessments. Classroom teachers will
  communicate with students and families if/when students will be engaging in the MAP Growth assessment.
- **REMINDER! Counseling Department Resources**: Annually, mental health organizations, agencies, schools, and individuals across the U.S. and world rally together to help, share resources, and create awareness of suicide prevention during September, Suicide Prevention Month.
