Important Upcoming Dates:

- **NEW! Birthday Treats:** Students are allowed to bring treats to school to share with their homeroom classmates to celebrate their birthday. This year, students are allowed to bring treats that are homemade; however, families must provide a list of ingredients for allergen information.
- **NEW! Halloween Costumes:** As Halloween approaches please keep the following expectations in mind before you send your student to school. Any costumes or dress up should be school appropriate, comply with all school rules, and be free from religious, political or socially controversial themes. There is an expectation that masks and props will not be worn or used during class, learning time, transitions, lunch or recess, but are welcome at classroom or grade level celebrations. No props or costumes should have weapons, and any props, masks, costumes deemed inappropriate will be asked to be removed.
