

If appropriate, a fluoride treatment and toothbrush instructions along with a new toothbrush will be provided. [Paper permission slips](#) were sent home with 4K-5th grade students on 9/29. If you would like your child to participate, please sign and return the form to the School Office by Tuesday, October 10th. Late permission slips will not be accepted.
