Important Information:

- **NEW! Spring Act 20 Early Literacy Assessment:** Students in 4K-3rd grade will be engaging in the spring early literacy assessments starting the week of April 7th. Results will be communicated to families in the next few weeks. We are excited to see how our students have grown this year!
- Forward Exam Grades 3-8: It's that time of year when our students showcase all they have learned so far this year on the Wisconsin Forward Exam. Please check communications from your grade 3-8 child's teacher regarding the testing schedule that will be occurring between March 17 April 25. On testing days, families can support Bristol School by ensuring their children get a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast. Additionally, we would love family support in encouraging and cheering on our students to do their very best. Scores on the exam are not factored into student grades; however, by doing well, we communicate that Bristol School is an amazing place to learn and grow! Let's go Renegades!
- Academic & Career Planning (ACP) & Future Ready Updates: As part of school counseling lessons in grades K-5, we have recently started using Xello for Elementary as part of our ACP and future-ready efforts. Middle school students have been using Xello since 2019, continuing their ACP as part of school counseling lessons. Xello is used by schools across the state for students in grades 6-12. Through Xello, our K-8th grade students can explore their interests, life skills, and future possibilities in an engaging, age-appropriate way. Learn more here: The ACP Process.
- **North Parking Lot:** The traffic in the north parking lot for drop-off in the morning is becoming busy and dangerous. As a reminder here are the drop-off expectations:
 - Stay off of the phone and avoid other distractions such as pets in your lap.
 - Do not wait until you are at the door to drop students off.
 - Adults should remain in the vehicle in the drop-off lane.
 - Students should not be let out of the car without being accompanied by an adult unless they are in the drop-off lane
 - The north parking lot is for students in grade 4K-2nd grade or those with siblings that age. Students in grades 3rd-8th grade without younger siblings should be dropped off using the Hwy 45 parking lot entrance.
 - Please consider using the school bus.
