- **S.A.F.E.R Program:** The Kenosha Sheriff's Office is partnering with the Kenosha Police Department to provide this valuable tool to our county residents and schools. The S.A.F.E.R. Program is designed to collect and share critical information about individuals with special needs, making it easier and safer for officers to assist them during calls for service. Citizens can fill out a simple online form to provide details and upload photos. A QR code is attached to the flyer. I'll have a deputy deliver some to your respective schools. After a citizen submits information about their family member, an internal form will be completed, and this information will be added to our law enforcement software program. An alert will be created for that individual, and any responding officer can click on the alert to review critical information about the subject before making contact. This could include the individual's condition, potential triggers, effective de-escalation techniques, emergency contact info, and photos for quick ID. [S.A.F.E.R](#)
