Important Reminders:

- **Bristol School Spelling Bee:** January 22nd at 8:00am in the large gym. Parents (caregivers) are warmly invited to attend in person and cheer on our contestants. For those who cannot make it, the event will be live-streamed! You can find the streaming link on the [Bristol School Website](#).

- **Updated Guidelines for our Afternoon Dismissal:** To ensure the **safety of all students** and a smooth transition at the end of the school day, we have **partnered with the Kenosha Sheriff's Department** to develop the following dismissal plan and zipper line.
 - **The "Zipper Line" (Hwy 45 Side):** This area is strictly for quick pick-up only. Drivers must remain in their vehicles at all times. Please pull forward as space allows to keep the line moving.
 - **Park and Walk:** If you prefer to park and personally meet your student, please use the designated [parking areas by Door 2, 83rd street entrance](#). You must meet your child at the front of the building rather than the zipper line.
 - **Parking Prohibitions:** Please note that **parking and pulling around in the zipper line is strictly prohibited**. This stalls the flow of traffic and creates safety hazards for other vehicles.
 - **Safe Loading:** Please have your students enter the vehicle from the **passenger side only**. This keeps them away from active traffic in the passing lane.
