### Upcoming Events:

- **NEW** To help our students stay focused, we are reinforcing our phone-free environment. This isn't just a Bristol school preference; Wisconsin Act 42 (signed in October 2025) now requires all districts to prohibit cell phone use during the school day. This requirement is also reflected in our *District Policy - 5136* to ensure we are doing everything we can to support our students' mental health and learning. As a reminder, students are allowed to bring their cell phones to school, but need to keep their cellphones in their lockers (turned off) during the school day. A reminder that the school bus is an extension of our school day. To protect student privacy, we require phones to be put away on the bus, just as they are in class.
- **NEW Forward Exam Grades 3-8:** It's that time of year when our students showcase all they have learned so far this year on the Wisconsin Forward Exam. Please check communications from your grade 3-8 child's teacher regarding the testing schedule that will be occurring between **March 30th - April 9th**. On testing days, families can support Bristol School by ensuring their children get a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast. Additionally, we would love family support in encouraging and cheering on our students to do their very best. Scores on the exam are not factored into student grades; however, by doing well, we communicate that Bristol School is an amazing place to learn and grow! Let's go Renegades!
- **NEW Kindness Academy Bookmarks:** During February school counseling lessons on kindness, 4K-5th gr. students were invited to color bookmarks as part of our "Leave Your Mark with Kindness" project. More than 400 bookmarks are currently displayed in our school and will be donated to the Community Library - Salem Lakes Branch before our spring break, where they will be shared with readers as a small act of kindness in our community from Bristol School.
