- **Forward Exam Grades 3-8:** It's that time of year when our students showcase all they have learned so far this year on the Wisconsin Forward Exam. Please check communications from your grade 3-8 child's teacher regarding the testing schedule that will be occurring between March 30th - April 9th. On testing days, families can support Bristol School by ensuring their children get a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast. Additionally, we would love family support in encouraging and cheering on our students to do their very best. Scores on the exam are not factored into student grades; however, by doing well, we communicate that Bristol School is an amazing place to learn and grow! Let's go, Renegades!
- **Spring Update from the School Nurse:** Hello Bristol Families: We are still seeing influenza, strep, and stomach viruses make their way through the school, so please help us to stop the spread by keeping your child home if they display any of the following symptoms. Fever, headache that is accompanied by a stomachache and or sore throat, vomiting, or diarrhea. They must be fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication (Tylenol/ibuprofen), free from vomiting and diarrhea for 24 hours, and have no persistent cough (coughing every 20-60 seconds) that may distract from learning.
- **Kindness Academy Bookmarks:** During February school counseling lessons on kindness, 4K-5th grade students were invited to color bookmarks as part of our "Leave Your Mark with Kindness" project. More than 400 bookmarks were displayed in our school and donated to the Community Library - Salem Lakes Branch before our spring break, where they will be shared with readers as a small act of kindness in our community from Bristol School.
