- **Medical Care Plans and Medications Needed at School:** Any student that requires a medicine at school must complete the [medical authorization form](#) or an emergency health plan along with making arrangements with the school nurse to drop off the medication. Families must complete a medication authorization form for any over-the-counter or prescription medications without specific care plans (e.g., ADHD meds, pain relievers).
