Important Reminders:

- We have partnered with the Kenosha County Sheriff's Office to help ensure the safety of all students and staff during pick up. If you are picking up your child at dismissal, ***you must follow proper pick up procedures.***
 - 4K - 2nd Grade pick up line is on the North side of the building.
 - 3rd - 8th grade pick up line is on the Hwy 45 side of the building.
 - If you are in the pick up line, you must stay in the pick up line and follow the flow of traffic. No exiting the line, cutting into traffic.
 - There is NO Parking at pickup! This includes the handicapped spaces.
 - Please refrain from using your cell phones while in the pick up line.
