Dear Bristol Families,

It is critically important that we support each other and our Bristol School community during this uncertain time. Given the situation, we still remain committed to providing the best possible learning opportunities and supports for our students and their families.

Please carefully review the notices and updates below as they contain timely and important information.

### **Timely Important Notices:**

- **On Tuesday, March 17, Bristol School will be open from 7am to 6pm\*** for adults to pick up their children's personal items, such as but not limited to books, school packets, school supplies and medication.
- **All parents are encouraged to pick up their child's medicine** on Tuesday, March 17 from 7am to 6pm\*. *At the time of picking up your child's medicine, you will be asked to complete and turn in Bristol's Medication Pick Up Form.*
- **Bristol School has a limited amount of chromebooks and chargers to check out to families without these devices at home.** If your Bristol student needs to check out a chromebook, visit the Bristol School library between 7am and 6pm, Tuesday, March 17\*. *The [District's Acceptable Use Policy \(po7540.03\)](#) must be followed.*
- **To sign up for [Bristol's Weekly School Meal Delivery Program](#), please complete this [google form](#) by Wednesday, March 18 at 6pm.** Bristol's Weekly School Meal Delivery program is anticipated to begin on Thursday, March 19 and end on Friday, April 3. *This program is designed to support families who rely on school meals for their children. Remember if your family is currently NOT enrolled in the free/reduced meal program, your students' lunch account will be charged the full meal rate for each meal times the number of days.*

*\*Enter at Door 2 (main office) or Door 12 (hwy. 45); please keep your time in the building brief and be mindful of social distancing.*



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## Curriculum Off-Campus Learning Update:

- Bristol Teachers are in the planning stages to provide off-campus learning, mainly through Google Classroom and other Google Apps. There may be other options depending on grade level.
- It is encouraged for Bristol students to use their own home devices if at all possible; Bristol School has a limited number of chromebooks available to check out for students who do not have access to devices.
- Classroom teachers will be communicating as regularly as possible with Bristol parents and/or Bristol teachers and will be asked to set-up a one-to-one communication each week with students/families, if possible, to answer questions and provide guidance on learning targets.

- **Skyward: Family Access Support Ticket:** Complete this [google form](#) to submit a request to reset your password. *Once your form is submitted, a Bristol Office Staff member will be in contact to provide a temporary password.*
