- Deployment of Phones/train a Bristol Tech on deployment of phones
- Setup of all mailboxes, extensions, auto attendants, call routing and any other feature deemed necessary to improve the efficiency of call handling/communications
- Integrate the phone system with Skyward/Skyalert (if necessary)
- Provide end user training on phones
