Wisconsin DOJ 2018 School Safety Initiative

This summer the Wisconsin Department of Justice awarded Bristol School District #1 \$22,925 in grant money to reconfigure our front entryway which was completed in August. This grant money allowed us to ensure a safe environment for students, staff, and the school community. Visitors now have to be let into a corridor where they will check in with office staff. Using our Raptor Technologies system, it allows for each visitor to be screened against custom database as well as keeps an accurate record of every visitor that enters the school. Once the visitor is cleared by office staff, if reasons permit, they will be allowed to enter the building.

In September, we completed another round of grants and were awarded \$31,478 to make continuous improvements to our school in regards to safety. The grant will allow for staff members to attend ALiCE Instructor Certification Training, School Violence Threat Assessment Team Training as well as Adolescence Mental Health Training. Security cameras as well as door handles and locks will be updated with this grant money. We have also provided safety materials for staff including Trauma Kits.

During our 2018-2019 Teacher Inservice this August, staff members and local partners joined efforts to better prepare ourselves for a traumatic experience. Our staff learned different life-saving measures from local first responded teams like the Bristol Fire & Rescue Department. This training session allowed for staff to become trained on trauma-sensitive matters along with preparing them with techniques to help in traumatic situation.
