### SHELTER-IN-PLACE DRILL

Sheltering provides refuge for students, staff and public within school building during an emergency (weather, civic, community).



#### **EVACUATION DRILL**

Evacuation procedures are implemented when conditions outside the building are safer than those inside.



#### **LOCKDOWN DRILL**

After an ALERT is made and individuals are INFORMED of a threat. Building occupant movement is completely restricted. Lights are off, doors locked, barricades as needed. As situation evolves, examine the situation and either EVACUATE or COUNTER.



#### SAFETY HOLD

Student movement through hallways needs to be restricted.



# BUILDING ACCESS

Bristol School uses Raptor software to monitor all visitors during school hours and identify anyone who may compromise school safety. Raptor scans visitors state-issued IDs and screens them against a national database. If a concern is identified administration is alerted.
