2024 LAWN SERVICE BIDS

- All grass and roadside ditches to be cut and trimmed weekly or as directed by Louis Gillmore/Building and Grounds Supervisor. Trimming is to include the side fences of all the baseball diamonds along 203rd Avenue and 83rd Street and around the west and south side of the building.
- 2. General clean-up and neat appearance will be maintained.
- 3. Times and areas of mowing must be coordinated with Louis Gillmore/Building and Grounds Supervisor.
- 4. Outdoor maintenance or work, at time and material, (fertilizing, etc.) as requested. Most work will be done by the school staff.
